## Outline Syllabus

Additionally they will strengthen their awareness of idioms and different styles in the target language. This will be achieved through a range of material drawn from the media and other contemporary sources to underpin the learning activities.*

## Learning Activities

Group activities, pair work, team work and individual study aiming to develop to a high level the four skills of reading, writing, speaking and listening. Activities may cover, for example, topic-based discussion, presentations, application of grammar using different registers, report writing, extended writing focusing on a variety of styles (from the plain to the honourifics) and use of appropriate ICT tools and resources, an introduction to liaison interpreting skills in face-to-face discussion situations.
